ABOUT THE DOMAINE

Purchased in 2000 by Dominique Hébrard, former owner of Chateau Cheval Blanc, the historic 14,5 hectare Chateau Trianon Saint-Emilion Grand Cru estate is in the south-west part of Saint-Emilion. Since the beginning of his ownership Dominique has focused on creating the highest quality wines; overseeing significant investment and re-organisation of the vineyard and winery. The ultimate ambition for Chateau Trianon is to achieve Grand Cru Classé status. In addition to the Saint-Emilion Grand Cru there is a second wine, Pavillon de Trianon.

WINEMAKING

The wine is partially fermented in thermoregulated stainless steel tanks (75%) and 25% in Oak barrels.

TASTING NOTES

The wine has a pale straw colour. The nose is intense with aromas of citrus, grapefruit, and gooseberry, followed by subtle hints of white flowers. On the palate, the wine reveals a harmonious balance between the lively acidity with aromas of lemon, lime and ripe peach linger on the finish.
