ABOUT THE DOMAINE

Purchased in 2000 by Dominique Hébrard, former owner of Chateau Cheval Blanc, the historic 14,5 hectare Chateau Trianon Saint-Emilion Grand Cru estate is in the south-west part of Saint-Emilion. Since the beginning of his ownership Dominique has focused on creating the highest quality wines; overseeing significant investment and reorganisation of the vineyard and winery. The ultimate ambition for Chateau Trianon is to achieve Grand Cru Classé status. In addition to the Saint-Emilion Grand Cru there is a second wine, Pavillon de Trianon.

WINEMAKING

Clayey sand on iron oxide-rich stony clay and red gravel. The fruit is hand-picked and carried in crates. The fruit is transferred by gravity alone to the winery. Two vibrating tables initially and two sorting tables. Temperature-controlled stainless steel tanks, pyramid shaped concrete vats and stainless steel truncated inverted cone shaped tanks. Extraction is gentle at carefully observed temperature levels. Malolactic transformation takes place in new barrels and tanks. The wine is aged for 16 Months, 70% in new oak barrels and 30% in old oak barrels.
