### ABOUT THE DOMAINE

Anton Bauer is a 29-hectare family-owned estate located in Wagram. It has been run by the 4<sup>th</sup> generation since 1992 when Anton Bauer took over the 3.2-hectare winery from his parents after studying oenology and training in Burgundy. Anton's winemaking philosophy is centred around the uncompromisingly pursuit of quality, paying particular attention to underlining features of the terroir that are reflected in the unique character of his wines.

### WINEMAKING

Controlled fermentation in steel tank. Aged for 16 months in steel, large oak barrel and used barrique.

### TASTING NOTES

Classic colour, medium density, purple and carmine, boiled edge; youthful fruit on the nose, with vegetal and herbal supplement, still youthful, a little bit restrained; Sweet roasted on the palate, elegant berry aromas and chocolates, fine, cooked fruit fullness, delicate roasted notes as a complement, juvenile toasting with some coffee notes, extra sweet and elegant finish.
