ABOUT THE DOMAINE

Bodegas Yuste is a family-owned collection of several small wineries located in the historic city of Sanlúcar de Barrameda. The company was founded in 1991 by Francisco "Paco" Yuste, the owner of a successful drinks distributorship, when he purchased the historic Bodega Santa Ana and its centenarian solera. This bodega used to belong to the Rainera Pérez Marín family and is now the residence of the Yuste family. Dedicated to the founder's late mother Caridad ('Kika'), this Manzanilla Pasada 'La Kika' from Bodegas Yuste is a relatively new product on the market. It used to be bottled only for the family and close friends.

WINEMAKING

The 400-butt solera is over a century old and located in the historic Bodega Santa Ana in Sanlúcar's Barrio Bajo. For this wine, the barrels showing the most complexity are selected from the first criadera and bottled by hand with minimal filtering. It is approximately 10 years old – about as old as Manzanilla will get.

TASTING NOTES

Very intense flor notes, with rich hints of hay, flax, toasted almonds and hazelnuts. Just a hint of baked apple in the background. Herbal infusion and buttery notes. There's flor and brine, bitter almonds and just a hint of citrus acidity. Light yeasty notes. Dried flowers. Light iodine. Very long and amazingly fresh. Perfect with langostinos, jamon Iberico, seafood, fish stews, cheeses etc.
