ABOUT THE DOMAINE

Over 300 years ago, François Dubois planted his first vines on the hillsides in Reignac de Blaye. Nine generations later, Laurent and his wife Isabelle continue the family tradition of cultivating the noble land of Château Les Bertrands. Over the years, successive investment in vines has extended the size of the vineyard to the hundred plus hectares it is today.

WINEMAKING

Grape harvested at optimum maturity, sorting table, destemming, crushing, maceration and fermentation in thermo-regulated stainless steel vats. Aged in steel and cement tanks for 15 months. The average age of the vines are 25 years old. Gravel, fine sands and coarse soil type.

TASTING NOTES

Aromas of red fruits, especially cassis, raspberry and cherry, on the nose. Supple attack with elegant tannins. Round, rich and powerful pallet. Long, pleasant finish.
