ABOUT THE DOMAINE

Château Paveil de Luze is one of the oldest properties in the Medoc, the incredible 120-hectare estate was founded by Baron Alfred de Luze in 1862. The Chateaux is a family-led estate being passed through 7 generations. Today, it is important that the Chateau take an environmental approach to their winemaking practices to respect the terroir and the environment; through sustainable cultivation, water management, treatment of cellar effluents and soil decompaction. The combination of sand and gravel soils found in this area of southern Medoc are ideal to support both Cabernet Sauvignon and a high proportion of Merlot. The Chateau is currently owned by Frederic De Luze, and Stephane Fort is his cellar master, they collectively work to ensure harmonious development of the vineyard, vinify the grapes with passion, and are meticulous in each step of the wine process, through to the aging, from vine to bottle.

WINEMAKING

12 months in oak barrels, 20% new. The 2010 vintage for Bordeaux is recognized as legendary across the board. The average age of the vines are 35 years old.

TASTING NOTES

Delivers ripe dark berries, truffle and floral notes with hints of espresso and liquorice. Silky smooth tannins, an open accessible style, a long, soft finish with earthy tones. Lovely, mature claret.
