ABOUT THE DOMAINE

Clos Le Comte, located in Preignac in the heart of the Sauternes AOC (40kms south of Bordeaux) is an eight hectare domaine, six of which are in Sauternes; the remaining two are in Graves. The vineyards were first planted in 1929 and have been under the ownership of Jean Michel and Celine Lecomte since 2000. Working with passion and rigour, the Lecomtes practice "agriculture raisonée" working as near to organically as possible to ensure their wines are of the highest quality.

WINEMAKING

Fermented in barriques, then aged for 12 months in French and American oak. Gravel soil and limestone. The average age of the vines are 40 years old.

TASTING NOTES

Attractive earthy notes restrain vibrant flavours of blackcurrant, ripe plum and black cherry on the palate- a nicely balanced wine.



TECHNICAL NOTES

Alcohol by volume 13.5%
