## Domaine Gerard Boyer Auxey-Duresses 'Les Ruchottes'

### ABOUT THE DOMAINE

Maison Gérard Boyer is a seven-hectare property located mainly in Côte de Beaune, in the commune of Meursault. Winegrowers for five generations, the domaine has constantly evolved. Gérard Boyer took over the reins in the 1980s, and modernised traditional winemaking approaches, developed a network of customers and acquired new appellations by the 2000s. Maison Gérard Boyer cultivate vines, vinify the grapes and produce the wines with respect for tradition. In order to expand the appellations from Burgundy, the property, also buy some wine cuvées from small winegrowers.

### WINEMAKING

The grapes are pressed pneumatically, this pressing is soft and respectful, to extract the best juices. The collected juices are cooled to 12°C and they stand for 24 hours. Fermentation takes place using wild yeasts and wines are aged on fine lees in barrel for 11 months.

### TASTING NOTES

The colour is bright. The nose gives off delicate aromas of white flowers, butter, citrus, and spices. The palate is full, round, and rich, supported by subtle oak and well-balanced acidity.
