ABOUT THE DOMAINE

Passed down from father to son for five generations, Domaine Boussey is a family-run estate located in Monthélie (near Meursault, Pommard and Beaune), a region that is world-renown for its Burgundian wines. Since 2003, Laurent Boussey and his wife, Karen, run the 14-hectare estate. Both trained winemakers, they work the vines following family traditions: with respect for the environment, pruning and harvesting by hand.

WINEMAKING

The vinification in white begins with a soft pressing of grapes from Chardonnay, followed by low-temperature fermentation during several days in order to obtain the fruity and sensual delight of the Grands Blancs of Burgundy. These wines will be held in oak barrels, with proportions of new barrels varying from 10 to 50%. Low-temperature fermentation during several days then aged in oak barrels for 12 months.

TASTING NOTES

Golden green colour with aromas of hawthorn, lime and flint. Structured, with great length and aging potential. Suggested food pairings: as an aperitif or with fish or comté cheese.
