ABOUT THE DOMAINE

Domaine du Peras is an independent vigneron in Abeilhan, 15 kms north of Beziers. Not only does Mathieu Merlet, the owner/winemaker, like to focus on single grape varieties in order for the consumer to know what is in the glass, but he goes as far as harvesting at night time in order to keep the freshness, and the fruitiness, in the wine rather than the oxidised touch or cooked fruit taste which can be found in so many wines of the region.

La Guerre des Bouchons Blanc , produced by Domaine du Peras , comes from carefully selected grapes grown on clay-limestone soils characteristic of Languedoc. This wine reflects the estate's commitment to producing accessible, expressive wines that respect their terroir.

WINEMAKING

Grapes are always harvested at night to maximise freshness and fruitiness. Vinified in stainless steel tanks using short skin maceration methods. The average age of the vines is between 5 and 10 years old. Sustainable viticulture practices.

TASTING NOTES

A blend of Chardonnay and Viognier, offering freshness, roundness and a beautiful aromatic intensity. Bright and crisp. Seductive aromas of white-fleshed fruits (peach, pear), citrus fruits (lemon, grapefruit) and white flowers, with a subtle touch of minerality.
