ABOUT THE DOMAINE

La Gabare is one of the last independent cognac houses. It was founded in 1992 by Jean Grosperrin, a cognac broker and merchant, who was able to capitalise on the close relationships he has with his clients, resulting in them allowing him to buy precious private stocks. Today, the family-owned company remains dedicated to the selection, ageing and sale of rare, old cognacs under the brand names "Cognac de Collection Jean Grosperrin" and "Cognac Le Roch." All of their products are verified and certified by the French National Scientific Research Institute guaranteeing their impeccable provenance and quality.

DISTILATION

Completely natural without additives (which includes wood extract flavouring, sugar, caramel or artificial colouring/flavouring.

TASTING NOTES

Blend of Grande Champagne and Petite Champagne (with a minimum of 50% Grande Champagne). Good alcoholic strength (42,5%) for an old cognac from a relatively humid cellar. The nose is prune, cinnamon and liquorice. The tannins are supple, oily and silky on the palate. No bitterness. There is a distinctive smoky scent.
