ABOUT THE DOMAINE

Founded in 2001 by siblings Federico, Balbino and Francesca Romana, the Terenzi estate spans 150 hectares in the Morellino di Scansano zone of the Maremma. With over 60 hectares of vines and a modern approach to environmental preservation, the family, along with celebrated winemaker Giuseppe Caviola, are on a quest for raising Morellino di Scansano to the highest level of quality and excellence. The management of the vineyards, the harvest of the grapes, wine making and bottling are all made with passion and care by a highly specialised and motivated staff led by Giuseppe Caviola, one of the most important winemakers in Italy and in the world.

WINEMAKING

Sangiovese picked by hand in Madre Chiesa vineyard, with deep soils of coarse sands and deep clay; very stony and well-drained. Destemmed and partial rupturing of the grapes. Pneumatic pressing. Fermentation in stainless steel tanks at a controlled temperature (28-30C). Malolactic fermentation carried out spontaneously, in stainless steel tanks. Maturation for 12 months in large Slavonian oak casks. Bottle aged for 6 months .

TASTING NOTES

Deep ruby red with garnet tinges. Red berry fruits, spices and a faint tarry note. Full-bodied and well-balanced, with ripe, well-evolved tannins. It goes particularly well with red meats, roasts, game or moderately mature cheese.
