### ABOUT THE DOMAINE

Trois Noix is French for 'three nuts', and is a homage to Founder, Jaime Araujo's love of France, and the commitment to using wine as a catalyst for social change. Trois Noix was founded in 2013 and was born out of a lifelong love of wine. Standing on that foundation today, this Estate is a bridge between "Established Napa" and "Next Napa," holding onto that sense of place while inviting as many people as possible to revel in their shared love of wine. While Trois Noix push the boundaries, they retain tradition in their winemaking. They make wines that are enjoyable and pleasurable – fresh, precise, and approachable with structure to last.

### WINEMAKING

In 2020 the Napa Valley experienced a very warm summer which led to full physiological ripeness that showcased intense fruits, but attentive picking decisions retained freshness and verve in the resulting wines. This wine has been aged for 22 months in 100% neutral French oak.

### TASTING NOTES

Very bright red fruits exude from the glass including Bing cherry and raspberry compote. Interlaced are moody notes of damp earth, cardamom and petrichor. The midpalate is generously weighted while a framework of acidity and pixelated tannin define this wine's fresh and flamboyant personality.
