ABOUT THE DOMAINE

Trois Noix is French for 'three nuts', and is a homage to Founder, Jaime Araujo's love of France, and the commitment to using wine as a catalyst for social change. Trois Noix was founded in 2013 and was born out of a lifelong love of wine. Standing on that foundation today, this Estate is a bridge between "Established Napa" and "Next Napa," holding onto that sense of place while inviting as many people as possible to revel in their shared love of wine. While Trois Noix push the boundaries, they retain tradition in their winemaking. They make wines that are enjoyable and pleasurable – fresh, precise, and approachable with structure to last.

WINEMAKING

In 2019 the Napa Valley experienced a nice long string of foggy mornings helped to preserve freshness while the fruit enjoyed nice and even ripening. This wine has been aged for 20 months in 100% new and neutral French oak.

TASTING NOTES

The 2019 Trois Noix Noisette Cuvée is a blend of Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon (75%) and Petit Verdot (25%) which come together to deliver intensity and poise. Vibrant notes of ripe plum, sage, wild game and cedar. Medium-bodied with firm tannins and a pleasingly long finish.
