ABOUT THE DOMAINE

Ulmus are quintessential expressions of some of the world most popular wines and grape varieties. Sourced from leading boutique producers by award-winning wine merchant, Top Selection, the range captures the essence of each region, combining the best possible value, quality and drinking pleasure. The wines are selected by and bottled exclusively for Top Selection, 3 time SWA UK Fine Wine Merchant of the Year.

The wine was created by Daniel Pi, one of Argentina's most talented winemakers.

WINEMAKING

Made in the Uco Valley in Mendoza, the heartland of the best Argentinian Malbec, the grapes for this wine have been sourced from two special sites. 50% from old vines in Vista Flores, dating back to 1945. The clay soils contribute roundness and enticing cherry and plum characteristics. The other half of the grapes are sourced from un-grafted vines in Gualtallary. The average age of the vines are 20 years old. The soil type is complex, consisting of sand and gravel, contributing acidity, chalky tannins, and a complex character.

The wine has been aged for 12 months in 225L French oak barrels. Unfiltered.

TASTING NOTES

Malbec is the flagship red wine from Argentina renowned for its intense colour and expressive fruit characteristics. Sourced from premier vineyard sites in the Uco Valley in Mendoza, this refined Malbec has enticing aromas of ripe black fruits and spice, which combine with silky smooth tannins to deliver a satisfying, lingering finish.
